Re: EB-2008-0099

We are counsel to the Consumers' Council of Canada. Our client applied for, and was granted, status as an intervenor in the Oshawa PUC Networks Inc. ("Oshawa PUC") application, which bears Board File No. EB-2007-0710, for the purpose of participating in the Motion filed by AMPCO.

The Decision And Procedural Order No. 1 in EB-2008-0099 requires that a party seeking costs in the proceeding file a letter to that effect. The purpose of this letter is to advise the Board, and Oshawa PUC, that our client will be seeking an order of costs in this proceeding.

Our client is a non-profit, public interest entity which represents the interests of the broad range of residential consumers of electricity and natural gas in Ontario. Our client has been an active participant in a number of applications by electricity LDCs, and in a number of other proceedings dealing with the regulation of the electricity sector in Ontario. Our client did not participate in the Oshawa PUC application simply because it did not have the resources to do so. However, the issues raised by the AMPCO Motion have implications for residential consumers of electricity not just within the service territory of the Oshawa PUC but across the province. It is for that reason that our client has obtained intervenor status for purposes of participating in the AMPCO Motion.

Our client has been found to be eligible for an award of 100% of its reasonably-incurred costs for all of the OEB matters in which it has participated. In the absence of a cost award, our client could not participate in the AMPCO Motion.
