**Natural Resource Gas (NRG) and Integrated Grain Processors Co-operative  
(EB-2012-0406 and EB-2013-0081)**

We are co-counsel to NRG in the above-noted combined proceeding. Further to the Board's Procedural Order No. 2 dated May 17, 2013, we are writing to request that the Board grant NRG a one-week extension for filing its responses to interrogatories (currently due June 21, 2013). The reasons for this request are as follows:

- (a) NRG received a number of detailed interrogatories from Board Staff and the Town of Aylmer, and also received 26 single-spaced pages of interrogatories from IGPC. This is significantly more than anticipated, and will require more than the nine days to respond.
- (b) Last week and this week, NRG's co-counsel (Mr. Larry Thacker) has been in full-day hearings before the Ontario Securities Commission. This hearing will finish this Friday.
