We are counsel to TransCanada PipeLines Limited, an intervenor in the above-captioned proceedings.

Procedural Order No. 2 set this Friday, June 28<sup>th</sup> as the date for the filing of intervenor evidence.

The Board will be aware that Calgary has recently experienced severe flooding, resulting in mandatory evacuations and the closing of the downtown core of the City. This resulted in the closure of the TransCanada office (which remains closed today) and the evacuation or stranding of a number of the TransCanada employees whose input is required for TransCanada to prepare its intervenor evidence. TransCanada's evidence will deal with its role in Segment A of the Enbridge GTA Project.

TransCanada requests that it be permitted to file its evidence on Friday, July 5<sup>th</sup>. This will require that returning employees work over the July long weekend, but we believe that the goal of filing by July 5<sup>th</sup> is achievable. TransCanada would propose that the deadline for interrogatories to TransCanada be extended to Friday July 12<sup>th</sup> and the deadline for TransCanada's responses be extended to Wednesday July 24<sup>th</sup>.
