Re: Bornish Wind, LP, Kerwood Wind, Inc. and Jericho Wind, Inc. Applications for Leave to Construct Transmission Facilities (EB-2013-0040,
EB-2013-0041) - Response to Intervenor Request for Filing Extension

We are counsel to the Applicants in the above-referenced proceedings. On June 26, 2013 we received an email from a colleague of Mr. Graham Andrews, requesting an extension to the deadline for filing interrogatory responses on behalf of the Intervenor Group from July 2, 2013 to July 15, 2013 due to Mr. Andrews' travel schedule. For the reasons that follow, the Applicants strongly oppose this request.

The July 2 deadline is established in Procedural Order No. 4, which was issued May 29th. Based on the automatic email response we received in recent correspondence to Mr. Andrews, we understand that he has been out of the office since June 15. Mr. Andrews has had ample opportunity to make appropriate arrangements to ensure the responses to interrogatories could be filed by the prescribed date. It is incumbent upon counsel to make such arrangements in anticipation of his travel plans.

The Intervenor Group is only responsible for responding to two short interrogatory questions, both of which have been posed by the Applicants. It would be unreasonable to delay the proceeding, and in turn the development of the Applicants' underlying projects, by nearly two weeks on account of Mr. Andrews' failure to make arrangements for the filing of responses to these two simple interrogatory questions.

Finally, we note that, in accordance with Procedural Order No. 2, Mr. Andrews is not actually counsel of record for the Intervenor Group, to whom the interrogatories are directed. Whereas both Mr. Andrews and Mr. Eric Gillespie are listed as counsel of record for the intervenor MLWAG Inc., only Mr. Gillespie is counsel of record for the Intervenor Group. On this basis, it is not clear as to why Mr. Andrews' absence would be such a critical factor in or relevant to the Intervenor Group's ability to respond to interrogatories.
