Dear Sir or Madam:

In reply to the email received on March 15, 2007 from Mr. William Garvin regarding clarification on the following aspects of the application, please accept this response from Niagara Falls Hydro.

1. "On the approved 2006 tariff schedule for Niagara Falls Hydro Inc., in the Allowances Section of the Specific Service Charges, the quantity used for Primary Metering Allowance for transformer losses is listed as % whereas on Sheet 3 of your 2007 IRM model, this quantity is listed as \$/kW.

There is no reference in your application explaining this discrepancy. Please clarify whether this was a simple oversight in completing the 2007 IRM Model. If not, please provide a full and complete explanation for removing the rate from the approved schedule. "

This is an oversight. The Primary Metering Allowance for transformer losses - applied to measured demand and energy is (1.00)%

2. " On sheet 7 of your 2007 IRM Model you have indicated that you received Board Approval for LCT Allowance in 2006 whereas our records indicate that you did not receive such approval.

There is no reference in your application explaining this discrepancy. Please clarify whether this was a simple oversight in completing the 2007 IRM Model. If not, please provide a full and complete explanation for the disparity."

This is an over sight, we did not receive LCT Allowance in 2006.
