DECISION AND ORDER

Sky Generation Inc. ("Sky") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board pursuant to section 74 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* for an order of the Board to amend its licence. The application was received by the Board on June 1, 2007.

Sky requested that the licence be amended to include additional generation facilities to be located at Ravenswood, Ontario. All other corporate information remains the same.

The licence amendment is granted.

Background

Sky stated that it is requesting this amendment due to the addition of proposed generation facilities to be located at its Ravenswood site at Lots 56, 57 and 58, Lakeshore Road East, and Lot 58, Lambton Shores West, Municipality of Lambton Shores, Ontario. These facilities will consist of five wind turbines with a total capacity of 8.25 MW.

Sky's existing generation facilities consist of three wind turbines located at Ferndale in the Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula, Ontario with a capacity totaling 5MW.

The applicant has advised that all municipal and provincial approvals in respect to zoning, official plan, Environmental Screening Report and Certificate of Compliance for Sound are in place.

Sky also agreed that the licence be updated to conform with the current Board-approved generation licence.

Licence Amendment

Pursuant to subsection 6(1) of the Act, I have been delegated the powers and duties of the Board with respect to the determination of applications made under section 74 of the Act. This order is made under the authority of that delegation and is based on the evidence filed in support of the application.

I have proceeded without a hearing pursuant to section 21(4)(b) of the Act since no other parties are adversely affected in a material way by the outcome of the licensing proceeding, and the applicant has consented to disposing of the application without a hearing.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

Sky Generation Inc's Electricity Generator Licence ER-2002-0367 is amended. The new licence is attached to this Order.

Under section 7(1) of the Act this decision may be appealed to the Board within 15 days.
