RE: EB-2012-0451/EB-2012-0433/EB-2013-0074 Union Gas Limited and Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. Leave to Construct Proceedings – Parkway West, Brantford to Kirkwall and GTA Reinforcement Projects

The Consumers Council of Canada has the following interrogatories for Gaz Metro Limited Partnership (“GMLP”) regarding its evidence filed on June 28, 2013, in the above-noted proceeding (Exhibit L.EGD.SCGM).

1. GMLP is proposing that Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. be required to hold an open season for Segment A of the GTA project. Is GMI of the view that there are other options that could accommodate the existing and incremental demands from Eastern markets? If so, please describe those options. Please provide how those options would compare in terms of cost to the EGD Project. If no other options are available, please explain why the expansion of EGD’s segment A is the only viable option?
2. If EGD is not required to hold an open season with respect to Segment A of its GTA Project, what steps will GMLP take to meet the needs of its end users?
