1. [p. 7] With respect to Gaz Métro customers who have chosen to manage their commodity purchases, please provide the quantity of volumes delivered at Empress and delivered to Gaz Métro service territory over the past 5 years and projected volumes for each year through 2017.
2. [p.9] Please provide English copies of Régie de l'énergie decisions D-2012-0175 and R-3809-2012.
3. [p.13] Please explain why in response to TCPL decision to postpone its Mainline expansion, "customers who had previously elected to source their transportation needs from the secondary market are now requesting that the distributor provide them with transportation".
4. [p.14] What are Gaz Métro's other options for meeting its future supply requirements if it is unable to access capacity on Enbridge's proposed Segment A pipeline.
