Re: EB-2012-0451, EB-2012-0333 and EB-2013-0074

We write on behalf of Union Gas Limited and Gaz Métro in the above-noted matter.

We have had the opportunity to review the letter filed today by Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. Enbridge's letter is in respect of the motion by Union and Gaz Métro to, among other things, seek relief in relation to Enbridge's GTA Project. The notice of motion was submitted to the Board on June 21, 2013. A hearing of the threshold issue identified by the Board – whether the Board's *Storage and Transportation Access Rule* ("STAR") applies to Segment A of the GTA Project – is scheduled for tomorrow.


In its letter, Enbridge has agreed that STAR applies to Segment A and has committed to: (1) hold an open season in respect of new capacity on Segment A by no later than July 25, 2013; and (2) ensure that the open season is in compliance with STAR. Enbridge has further agreed that an NPS 42 size pipe is required in respect of Segment A.

We understand that Enbridge has now terminated its memorandum of understanding with TransCanada PipeLines Limited referred to in Union and Gaz Métro's notice of motion.

In the circumstances, and based on the commitments contained in Enbridge's evidence referred to above, the agreement that an NPS 42 size pipe is required and on the termination of the memorandum of understanding, Union and Gaz Métro respectfully withdraw their motion. They

reserve their right to renew the motion if the commitments and agreement referred to in Enbridge's evidence are not fulfilled.
