In determining the amount of costs awarded to NOACC we ask the Board to consider:

- 1. The NOACC Coalition has, and will continue to collaborate, represented by Weiler, Maloney, Nelson, to provide their collective questions, submissions and argument in relation to not only issues related to energy but also to environmental and other social imperatives, including but not limited to social imperatives that are peculiar to the geographical, economic and commercial needs of the Northwest Region. NOACC, The City, CVNW and NOMA have been and will continue to be proponents of coordinated, comprehensive planning, development and support of electricity infrastructure and policy changes in the Northwest as a Region.
- 2. NOACC is careful to keep attendances by additional counsel and consultants at a minimum.
- 3. NOACC as the lead member of the NOACC Coalition represented the direct interest of ratepayers, in their capacity as small commercial and business consumers, throughout the Northwest Region.
- 4. NOACC represents the member businesses of the individual Chambers of Commerce throughout the Northwest Region and as such, understands and can speak to the direct commercial and business interests of the business and commercial ratepayers in the Northwest Region (population approximately 250,000).
- 5. NOACC performed an extensive and in depth survey of its membership, specifically in relation to this consultation initiative and the issues identified by the Board in the Staff Discussion Paper. The results of the survey of NOACC membership formed NOACC's comment on the Staff Discussion Paper.
- 6. NOACC has access to the information about, and the analysis of, electrical and power system needs in the Northwest Region that has been developed by the Energy Task Force (ETF). The ETF is an informal regional research committee of interested and experienced individuals who by living and working in the northwest are keenly aware of the geographical and technical issues relating to electricity generation, transmission and distribution in the Northwest Region, including micro-embedded generation issues.
- 7. NOACC is keenly aware, therefore, of the geographical, technical and policy issues relating to electricity generation, transmission and distribution in the Northwest Region, including issues faced by its membership in relation to microembedded generation and as such is well suited to provide important and unique

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perspectives in this policy review of micro-embedded generation connection issues.

- 8. There has been continual co-operation by NOACC with the Energy Task Force, NOMA, CVNW as well as the City to collect and consult with relevant stakeholders in the Northwest Region, including First Nations, and large and small industry, business consumers and municipalities.
- 9. Many issues in this consultation process were technical in nature and therefore review of literature and research on complex topics.
