DECISION AND ORDER ON COST AWARDS August 7, 2013

Background

PowerStream Inc. ("PowerStream") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on March 13, 2013, seeking Board approval for a Direct Install Refrigeration program. The Board assigned file number EB-2013-0070 to this application.

On April 24, 2013, the Board issued Procedural Order No. 1, granting the Building Owners and Managers Association Toronto ("BOMA") and the Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition ("VECC") intervenor and cost award eligibility status. On June 21, 2013, the Board issued its Decision and Order, in which it set out the process for intervenors to file their cost claims and to respond to any objections raised by PowerStream.

Cost claims were submitted by BOMA and VECC. No letter of objection was filed by PowerStream.

Board Findings

The Board has reviewed the cost claims of BOMA and VECC. The Board finds that all parties are eligible for 100% of their reasonably incurred costs of participating in this proceeding.

THE BOARD THEREFORE ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Pursuant to section 30 of the Ontario *Energy Board Act, 1998*, PowerStream shall immediately pay the following amounts to the intervenors for their costs:
 - Building Owners and Managers Association Toronto \$7,316.70; and
 - Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition \$2,195.73.
- Pursuant to section 30 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, PowerStream shall pay the Board's costs of and incidental to, this proceeding immediately upon receipt of the Board's invoice.
