NOTICE OF INTERVENTION OF THE INDEPENDENT ELECTRICITY SYSTEM OPERATOR

- 1. The Independent Electricity System Operator (the "IESO") received notice of the application on August 19, 2013. The IESO seeks to intervene and participate in the hearing of this matter. The IESO may make written submissions or participate in oral hearings as required.
- 2. The IESO is a non-profit, non-share capital corporation established under the *Electricity Act*, 1998 to administer the Ontario wholesale power markets and to direct the operation and maintain the reliability of the IESO-controlled grid. The IESO's responsibility for directing the operation and maintaining the integrity of the IESO-controlled grid is more precisely set out in the Market Rules and IESO license which, among other things, obligates the IESO to undertake a system impact assessment of proposed new or modified connections to the IESO-controlled grid.
- 3. As such, the IESO is an interested party and has an interest in all aspects of the proceeding. The IESO intends to participate by responding to pertinent enquiries as necessary, or as requested by the Board with respect to the IESO's review and assessment of the reliability and operational impact of the proposed project. The IESO may also make written submissions.
