NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND WRITTEN HEARING

APPLICATION FOR LICENCE TO DRILL ONE WELL WITHIN KIMBALL-COLINVILLE DESIGNATED STORAGE AREA

Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc (the "Applicant" or "Enbridge") filed an application dated June 6, 2013, for a well drilling licence with the Minister of Natural Resources. The application was referred to the Ontario Energy Board (the Board") by the Minister of Natural Resources on July 31, 2013, pursuant to section 40 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c.15 (schedule B).

Enbridge is seeking a license to drill one well in the Kimball-Colinville designated storage area:

• TKC #63, Moore 6-18-VIII

The proposed well is an observation well and does not require a pipeline to connect to the existing storage area. The observation well will be used to monitor the gas content and pressure in the underground storage area. A map showing the location of the proposed well is included as Appendix "A" in this Notice.

The Board has assigned File No. EB-2013-0289 to this application.

Written Hearing

The Board intends to proceed with this matter by way of a written hearing unless a party satisfies the Board that there is a good reason for not holding a written hearing. If you object to the Board holding a written hearing in this matter, you must provide written reasons why an oral hearing is necessary. Any submissions objecting to a written hearing must be received by the Board and copied to the applicant within **10 days** of the publication of this notice or the date it is served on you.

How to Participate

Comment

If you wish to give your opinion on the proceeding to the Board members hearing the application, you are invited to send a letter of comment to the Board no later than **30 days** after the publication of this notice or the date it is served on you. A complete copy of your letter of comment, including your name, contact information, and the content of the letter, will be provided to the applicant and the Board members hearing the application. All letters of comment will be placed on the public record, which means that the letters can be seen at the Board's offices and will be available on the Board's website. Before placing the letter of comment on the public record, the Board will remove any personal (i.e., not business) contact information from the letter of comment (i.e., the address, fax number, phone number, and e-mail address of the individual). However, the name of the individual and the content of the letter of comment to the Board Secretary at the address below, and reference file number **EB-2013-0289** at the top of your letter.

<u>Observe</u>

If you do not wish to actively participate in the proceeding but you do wish to receive documents issued by the Board, you may request observer status. Your written request must be received by the Board no later than **10 days** from the publication of this notice or the date it is served on you.
