LETTER OF COMMENT

Comments:

We are concerned that the 115kv transmission line needed to transport the power generated by the Niagara Region Wind Corp. wind farm will be placed in front of our property. We did not ask for this. This will result in the loss of property value, be unsightly and, from what we have read, cause serious health effects from the electrical energy being carried let alone the hazard of poles and drifting snow in winter.

The Township of West Lincoln has requested that the lines be buried but we understand that NRWC has refused to bury the lines due to cost. Is there not a price on health and wealth of the residents who were here first? In our case since 1957.

We have not been advised that any alternate routes have been considered and WHY NOT.

We understand that the OEB requirement is that the set back be 20-30m from homes when in fact research advises a set back of 200m from our homes.
