1. Purpose of this Form

This form is to be used to apply for a licence that would enable the applicant to generate electricity or provide ancillary services for sale through the Independent Electricity System Operator ("IESO") administered markets or directly to another person. Standard Offer Program generators should use the licence application form specified for Standard Offer Program generators, which can be found on the Board's website at www.ontarioenergyboard.ca.

This form is in a writeable PDF format. The applicant must either:

- type answers to all questions, print two copies and sign both copies; or
- print a copy of the form, clearly print answers to all questions, make a copy and sign both copies.

Sections 11 to 15 of this application will be treated as confidential. All other information filed as part of or in support of this application will be placed on the public record. Where the applicant objects to public disclosure of information contained in sections other than sections 11 to 15, the applicant must follow the procedure set out in the Board's Practice Direction on Confidential Filings.

Applicants must make a copy of the non-confidential sections of the application available to any person who requests a copy of the application.

A licensee may be subject to additional obligations as established under section 70 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998 and as required by a distributor, transmitter or the IESO.
