To begin with this whole idea of wind energy is a very costly alternative. The Provincial Auditor has made his report which should not be ignored. In his report he states that we are heading for financial disaster if we continue down the road of subsidizing, it does not work.

Any forward thinking person would not entertain NRWC and their high priced sales pitch. They are anything but good neighbors, when the host farmers are sworn to secrecy, what does that tell you. Further more all of the people living along this transmission line have not been notified, all of the residents along the route are affected.

I would also add that the Township of West Lincoln has passed a by-law saying the high voltage transmission line must be buried, nrwc has not complied. The Township of West Lincoln turned down the nrwc vibrancy fund which nrwc could use toward the cost to bury the line.

This project will only add more losses to the property owners along the route. I urge you not to comply with nrwc and their request.
