**Re: Dufferin Wind Power Inc. - Application for Authority to Expropriate (Board File No. EB-2013-0268)**

Dear Board Secretary,

On July 19, 2013, Dufferin Wind Power Inc. ("Dufferin") filed an application with the Board for authority to expropriate land for the purposes of constructing, operating and maintaining certain transmission and distribution facilities that will connect Dufferin's renewable energy generation facility to the IESO-controlled grid (EB-2013-0268). On July 24, 2013 Dufferin Wind received a letter from the Board acknowledging receipt of the application. As a notice of appeal was filed on August 2 by an intervenor in respect of the Board's decision granting Dufferin leave to construct and the Board had not issued a Notice of Application or Letter of Direction by mid-August, Dufferin filed a letter on August 21 setting out its views as to why the notice of appeal should not delay the Board's hearing of the expropriation application.

It has now been 8 weeks since Dufferin filed its expropriation application and the Board has yet to issue a Notice of Application or Letter of Direction or to otherwise determine any procedural matters in respect of the application. This delay is having a material and adverse impact on the Dufferin Wind Project. Given the importance of the Board's timely review and decision on the expropriation application for the project's schedule, budget and ability to achieve commercial operations in accordance with its FIT Contract, we respectfully reiterate our August 21 request that the Board issue a Notice of Application and Letter of Direction and commence hearing the expropriation application as soon as possible.
