The Electricity Distributors Association (EDA) is the voice of Ontario's 75 local distribution companies (LDCs), or electricity utilities, the publicly and privately owned companies that safely and reliably deliver electricity to all Ontarians through 4.8 million homes, businesses, and public institutions.

The EDA intends to participate in the Board's above hearing as an intervenor. The EDA acknowledges that this proceeding relates only to the attachment rates for Toronto Hydro. The EDA seeks to intervene because some of the principles to be considered may have implications for other LDCs or for other regulatory proceedings. The EDA does not intend to expand the scope of the evidence or the hearing beyond the particular circumstances of Toronto Hydro. Although the EDA does not anticipate filing for cost awards, it reserves the right to request cost eligibility for its participation if additional resources become necessary at a later stage in the proceeding.
