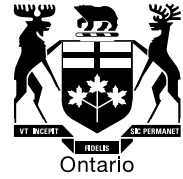

**Re: Application for Leave to Construct Transmission Facilities by: Goshen  
Wind, Inc. - Application Board File Number EB-2013-0096**

Reference is made to the above-captioned matter.

The Board has determined that a point of clarification is required with respect to the Record in this proceeding. The Board refers you to a letter dated May 29, 2013, filed by David M. Woodward, Solicitor, Lerner LLP of London, Ontario, on behalf of Earl Miller and Marilyn Miller. You are requested to advise the Board of the following:

- (a) Will any portion of the lands owned by Earl Miller and Marilyn Miller be sought by the Applicant for the purpose of constructing the proposed transmission line;
- (b) If the answer to (a) is negative will the lands of Earl Miller and Marilyn Miller be impacted in any other manner as a consequence of the construction of the proposed transmission line;
- (c) If the answer to (b) is positive will the Applicant seek to enter into an easement or licence agreement with Earl Miller and Marilyn Miller for the use of their lands?

The Board has decided to reopen the record in this proceeding for the limited purpose of receiving your reply to this request. Accordingly, you are requested to file two copies of your response. One version is to be marked confidential and should refer to the address and property description of the lands owned by Earl Miller and Marilyn Miller.

That version is to be filed confidentially with the Board in order to ensure that legal obligations concerning privacy are respected.

The second version is to be a redacted form of the above version of the letter with the address and property description for the lands owned by Earl Miller and Marilyn Miller removed or blacked out, in order that personal information concerning Mr. Miller and Ms. Miller is not inadvertently revealed on the public record.

An early and succinct response to these requests would be appreciated.
