AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Parry Sound Power Corporation for an order approving just and reasonable rates and other charges for electricity distribution to be effective January 1, 2014.

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1 September 24, 2013

Parry Sound Power Corporation ("Parry Sound Power") filed a complete application (the "Application") with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on August 16, 2013 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), and the Board's guidelines for 4th Generation Incentive Regulation Mechanism. (Name Abbreviation) is seeking approval for changes to the rates that PSPC charges for electricity distribution, to be effective January 1, 2014. The Board assigned the application file number EB-2013-0164.

The Board issued a Notice of Application and Hearing dated September 3, 2013. No party applied for intervenor status in this proceeding.

The Board has decided to make provision at this time for written interrogatories, interrogatory responses, submissions and reply submissions. The Board may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. Board staff shall request any information and material from Parry Sound Power that is in addition to Parry Sound Power's pre-filed evidence with the Board, and

that is relevant to the hearing, by written interrogatories filed with the Board and served to Parry Sound Power on or before **October 2, 2013**.

- 2. Parry Sound Power shall file with the Board complete written responses to the interrogatories on or before **October 17, 2013.**
- Board staff wishing to file a written submission shall do so by October 31, 2013. Any submission should be filed with the Board and delivered to Parry Sound Power.
- 4. Parry Sound Power may file a written reply submission with the Board by **November 14, 2013**.

All filings to the Board must quote the file number, EB-2013-0164, be made through the Board's web portal at <u>https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/</u>, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at <u>http://www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry</u>. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies.
