AND IN THE MATTER OF the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15 (Sched. B), as amended (the "Act");

AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Dufferin Wind Power Inc. ("DWPI") for an Order pursuant to Section 99(5) of the Act granting authority to expropriate land for the purposes of constructing, operating, maintaining transmission and distribution facilities that will connect DWPI's planned Dufferin Wind Farm to the IESO-controlled grid.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR INTERVENTION

- 1. The Corporation of the County of Dufferin (the "County") hereby applies for intervenor status.
- 2. The County owns certain lands, including the former railway corridor, that are impacted by this Application.
- 3. The County reserves its full rights to participate in this proceeding.
- 4. The wind project identified is currently the subject of an appeal being conducted with the Environmental Review Tribunal. Furthermore, we understand the leave to construct decision by this Board which provides DWPl's right to make this Application has been appealed to the Divisional Court.
- 5. We have reviewed prior correspondence available on the Board's website regarding this matter. Given the nature of the Application, we suggest the Board issue a procedural order that incorporates a preliminary motion or threshold issue of whether a stay of this Application should be granted in these circumstances.
- 6. As a landowner the County intends to seek costs for its participation in this proceeding.

 The County requests the Board confirm the County's eligibility for costs.
- 7. We request a hard copy of the Application be provided by the Applicant to the County and its legal counsel at the address below.
