Re: Application for Leave to Construct Transmission Facilities by: Goshen Wind Inc. - Application Board File Number EB-2013-0096

This acknowledges receipt of your cover letter dated September 20, 2013, and submission on two wind projects. Please note that in regard to the two noted projects, the Board has no jurisdiction regarding the need for and the location of the wind generation facilities that are associated with the relevant transmission line and related facilities.

The wind project identified in your letter as "Northland Power Limited" is related to a Board proceeding where on August 22, 2013, the Board issued a decision and order approving construction of transmission facilities by the Grand Bend Wind Limited Partnership (Board File Number: EB-2013-0185).

In regard to the project identified in your letter as "NextEra Energy Canada Limited" is related to the proceeding addressing the application by Goshen Wind Inc. requesting permission to construct a transmission line and related facilities. The Board notes that the Municipality of South Huron did not intervene in that proceeding, nor did it file a letter of comment during the time limits set out in the Board's procedural order issued in that case. The evidentiary phase of this proceeding was completed on August 6, 2013 and the Board can no longer receive new submissions. You can access the official records of this proceeding at the Board's website. The application by Goshen Wind Inc. remains under consideration by the Board at the present time.

The Board notes that the September 30 submission of the Municipality of South Huron appears to express the Municipality's concerns raised during a portion of the Renewable Environmental Approval ("REA") process as well as the applicant's response to those concerns. Any further pursuit of the Municipality's concerns should continue to be within the REA process.

For the reasons noted above, the Board is returning your submission, as it will not be considered by the Board's Panel dealing with this proceeding.
