IN THE MATTER OF the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, S.O. 1998, c.15, Schedule B, and in particular, S.90.(1) thereof;

AND IN THE MATTER OF an Application by Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. to the Ministry of Natural Resources for a license to drill a well in the existing Kimball-Colinville Designated Storage Area.

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1 September 30, 2013

Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. ("Enbridge") filed an application dated June 6, 2013, for a well drilling licence with the Minister of Natural Resources. The application was referred to the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") by the Ministry of Natural Resources on July 31, 2013, pursuant to section 40 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c.15 (schedule B). The Board has assigned **File No. EB-2013-0289** to this application.

Enbridge is seeking a license to drill an observation well (TKC #63, Moore 6-18-VIII) in the Kimball-Colinville designated storage area.

The observation well does not require a pipeline to connect to the existing storage area. It will be used to monitor the gas content and pressure in the underground storage area.

The Board issued a Notice of Application dated August 20, 2013. Enbridge served and published the Notice as directed by the Board. There are no registered intervenors or observers in the proceeding. The Board has decided to proceed by way of a written hearing.

The Board considers it necessary to make provisions for the following matters related to this proceeding. The Board may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Board staff may file written submissions with the Board, and deliver them to Enbridge by **October 7, 2013**.
- 2. If Enbridge wishes to file a response, the responding submission must be filed with the Board by **October 15, 2013**.

All filings to the Board must quote the file number, EB-2013-0289, be made through the Board's web portal at

https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry. If the web portal is not available, parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
