# ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD NOTICE TO CUSTOMERS OF BRANT COUNTY POWER INC.

**Brant County Power Inc. has applied to lower its electricity distribution rates.**

**Learn more.**

Brant County Power Inc. ("BCP") has applied to the Ontario Energy Board to decrease the amount it charges by approximately \$2.30 each month for the typical residential customer beginning on May 1, 2014. Other customers, including businesses, may be affected as well.

The requested rate decrease is tied to inflation (and other factors intended to promote efficiency).

## **THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD IS HOLDING A PUBLIC HEARING**

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) will hold a public hearing to consider BCP's request. We will determine whether BCP has used the applicable models and formulas as required by the OEB. At the end of this hearing, the OEB will decide on the appropriate rate changes.

The OEB is an independent and impartial public agency. We make decisions that serve the public interest. Our goal is to promote a financially viable and efficient energy sector that provides you with reliable energy services at a reasonable cost.

## **BE INFORMED**

You have the right to information regarding this application and to be involved in the process. You can:

- review BCP's application on the OEB's website now;
- sign up to observe the proceeding by receiving OEB documents related to the hearing; and
- at the end of the process, review the OEB's decision and its reasons on our website.

If you want to become an active participant (called an intervenor) in this proceeding, you must apply for intervenor status to the OEB no later than **10 calendar days** after the publication or service date of this notice, or the hearing will go ahead without you, and you will not receive any further notice of the proceeding. If you do not wish to become an intervenor but wish to give your opinion on the proceeding to the Board members hearing the application, you are invited to file a letter with your comments, which will be considered during the hearing.

The OEB does not intend to award costs in this proceeding as BCP has only made proposals of a mechanistic nature within the OEB's guidelines.
