**RE: EB- 2012-0433,0451 and EB-2013-0074 Follow-up on Requested Information**

The purpose of this letter is to request formally the provision of information committed to by the utilities pertaining to the Settlement Term Sheet (the "Settlement"). As was indicated at many times in the Technical Conference of September 12th, the ratepayer intervenors are keenly interested in understanding the details of how the Settlement is expected to affect transportation rates and the economics of the projects in this combined proceeding. At the conclusion of the last hearing date, Union Gas' counsel stated that the figures would be available by early Monday<sup>1</sup>.

We respect that we have had an unfortunate cancellation of the last two hearing days so it may appear that the urgency has been lifted. However, in our respectful submission, the hiatus ought to have provided additional time for the utilities and TCPL to provide intervenors with the promised deliverable for our review. At this time, all parties are unsure of when we would re-commence and what panel may be giving testimony. We emphasize that prompt delivery facilitates preparation of concise cross-examination of either the Joint Panel or Enbridge's Panel 3 regarding the economics of the projects.

By copy of this letter to the utilities, we respectfully request their communication of a date certain for the deliverable that the Board and intervenors can rely upon. Thank you.
