Re: Bornish Wind, LP, Kerwood Wind, Inc. and Jericho Wind, Inc. -Applications for Leave to Construct (EB-2013-0040 and EB-2013-0041) (the "Applications") - Request to Vary Procedural Order No. 9

We are counsel to Bornish Wind, LP, Kerwood Wind, Inc. and Jericho Wind, Inc. (the "Applicants") in the above-referenced proceedings. On September 19, 2013 the Board issued Procedural Order No. 9 (the "Order"), which provided for an additional round of interrogatories relating specifically to the Applicants' evidence update. In accordance with the Order, the Applicants' interrogatory responses are due October 7, 2013 and its Argument-in-Chief is due October 11, 2013 following which Board staff and intervenor submissions are due by October 18, 2013 and Applicant reply submissions are due by October 25, 2013.

However, as the number and scope of interrogatories actually received by the Applicants on September 30, 2013 was limited, the Applicants filed their responses on October 2, 2013. With the filing of the Applicants' interrogatory responses, the discovery phase of the proceeding came to a close. Due to there being minimal interrogatories, the Applicants were also in a position to file their Argument-in-Chief concurrently with the responses on October 2, 2013.

As this date is nine days in advance of the October 11, 2013 filing deadline established in the Order, and in light of the scheduling constraints described in Part E of the Applicants' Argument-in-Chief, the Applicants hereby request that the Board vary the Order by requiring Board staff and intervenors to file submissions on or before October 11, 2013 and for the Applicants to file reply submissions on or before October 18, 2013. There is no disadvantage to the intervenors or Board Staff as they would be provided with the same amount of time to reply to the Applicants' Argument-in-Chief as set out in the Order.
