**Re: EB-2013-0321 - OPG Application – GEC early intervention**

1. In anticipation of a notice of hearing being issued, and as counsel will be out of the country in the coming weeks, the Green Energy Coalition (GEC) hereby gives early notice of its intention to intervene in this matter and requests that it be found eligible for costs. GEC asks that this request be considered when it is timely to do so.

2. The GEC is comprised of David Suzuki Foundation, Greenpeace Canada, Sierra Club of Canada and World Wildlife Fund of Canada. GEC's member groups are charitable or non-profit organizations active on environmental and energy policy matters. The GEC has previously been found eligible for costs in related matters before the Board.

3. The groups' particular interest in these proceedings is, *inter alia*, in regard to the appropriateness of nuclear budgets, the proposal to pre-approve OPG's contracting strategy for major projects at Darlington, and any renewed proposal to pursue CWIP whether directly or by way of early clearance of capacity development and refurbishment variance accounts. GEC expects to be an active participant.
