Re: EB-2013-0321 - OPG Application - GEC early intervention

- 1. In anticipation of a notice of hearing being issued, and as counsel will be out of the country in the coming weeks, the Green Energy Coalition (GEC) hereby gives early notice of its intention to intervene in this matter and requests that it be found eligible for costs.
