PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1
October 8, 2013

Brant County Power Inc. ("BCP") filed a complete application (the "Application") with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on September 13, 2013 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), and the Board's guidelines for 4th Generation Incentive Regulation Mechanism. BCP is seeking approval for changes to the rates that BCP charges for electricity distribution, to be effective May 1, 2014. The Board assigned the Application file number EB-2013-0113.

The Board issued a Notice of Application and Hearing on September 20, 2013. No party applied for intervenor status in this proceeding.

The Board has decided to make provision at this time for written interrogatories, interrogatory responses, submissions and reply submissions. The Board may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. Board staff shall request any information and material from BCP that is in addition to BCP's pre-filed evidence with the Board, and that is relevant to the hearing, by written interrogatories filed with the Board and served to BCP on or before **October 17 2013**.

2. BCP shall file with the Board complete written responses to the interrogatories on or before **October 31, 2013**.
3. Board staff wishing to file a written submission shall do so by **November 14, 2013**. Any submission should be filed with the Board and delivered to BCP.
4. BCP may file a written reply submission with the Board by **November 28, 2013**.

All filings to the Board must quote the file number, EB-2013-0113, be made through the Board's web portal at www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.

All communications should be directed to the attention of the Board Secretary at the address below, and be received no later than 4:45 p.m. on the required date.
