IN THE MATTER OF the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B);

AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Lakeland Power Distribution Limited for an order approving just and reasonable rates and other charges for electricity distribution to be effective May 1, 2014.

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1 October 28, 2013

Lakeland Power Distribution Limited ("Lakeland Power") filed a complete application (the "Application") with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on September 25, 2013 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, *1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), and the Board's guidelines for 4th Generation Incentive Regulation Mechanism. Lakeland Power is seeking approval for changes to the rates that Lakeland Power charges for electricity distribution, to be effective May 1, 2014. The Board assigned the application file number EB-2013-0149.

The Board issued a Notice of Application and Hearing on October 7, 2013. No party applied for intervenor status in this proceeding.

The Board has decided to make provision at this time for written interrogatories, interrogatory responses, submissions and reply submissions. The Board may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Board staff shall request any information and material from Lakeland Power that is in addition to Lakeland Power's pre-filed evidence with the Board, and that is relevant to the hearing, by written interrogatories filed with the Board and served to Lakeland Power on or before **November 13, 2013**.
- 2. Lakeland Power shall file with the Board complete written responses to the interrogatories on or before **November 27, 2013.**
- Board staff wishing to file a written submission shall do so by December 18,
 2013. Any submission should be filed with the Board and delivered to Lakeland Power.
- 4. Lakeland Power may file a written reply submission with the Board by **January 15, 2014**.

All filings to the Board must quote the file number, EB-2013-0149, be made through the Board's web portal at https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at http://www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.

All communications should be directed to the attention of the Board Secretary at the address below, and be received no later than 4:45 p.m. on the required date.
