AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Chapleau Public Utilities Corporation for an order approving just and reasonable rates and other charges for electricity distribution to be effective May 1, 2014.

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1 October 31, 2013

Chapleau Public Utilities Corporation ("Chapleau Public Utilities") filed a complete application (the "Application") with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on September 10, 2013 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), under the Board's guidelines for an Incentive Regulation Mechanism. Chapleau Public Utilities is seeking approval for changes to the rates that Chapleau Public Utilities charges for electricity distribution, to be effective May 1, 2014. The Board assigned the application file number EB-2013-0119.

The Board issued a Notice of Application and Hearing on October 9, 2013. The Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition ("VECC") applied for intervenor status and cost eligibility in relation to Chapleau Public Utilities' proposals with regard to Low Voltage Service. No objection was received.

The Board approves VECC as an intervenor and has also determined that VECC is eligible to apply for an award of costs under the Board's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards* in relation to Chapleau Public Utilities' proposals with regard to Low Voltage Service. The list of parties in this proceeding is attached as Appendix A to this procedural order.

The Board has decided to make provision at this time for written interrogatories, interrogatory responses, submission and reply submission. The Board may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Board staff and the intervenors shall request any information and material from Chapleau Public Utilities that is in addition to Chapleau Public Utilities' pre-filed evidence with the Board, and that is relevant to the hearing, by written interrogatories filed with the Board and served on Chapleau Public Utilities on or before **November 7, 2013**.
- 2. Chapleau Public Utilities shall file with the Board complete written responses to the interrogatories and serve them on VECC on or before **November 21, 2013.**
- Board staff and intervenors wishing to file a written submission shall do so by December 5, 2013. Any submission should be filed with the Board and delivered to Chapleau Public Utilities and intervenors.
- 4. Chapleau Public Utilities may file a written reply submission with the Board, and deliver it to intervenors by **December 19, 2013**.

All filings to the Board must quote the file number, EB-2013-0119, be made through the Board's web portal at <u>https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/</u>, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at <u>http://www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry</u>. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
