IN THE MATTER OF the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B);

AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Midland Power Utility Corporation for an order approving just and reasonable rates and other charges for electricity distribution to be effective May 1, 2014.

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1 November 12, 2013

Midland Power Utility Corporation ("Midland PUC") filed a complete application (the "Application") with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on October 10, 2013 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), and the Board's guidelines for 4th Generation Incentive Regulation Mechanism. Midland PUC is seeking approval for changes to the rates that Midland PUC charges for electricity distribution, to be effective May 1, 2014. The Board assigned the Application file number EB-2013-0151.

The Board issued a Notice of Application and Hearing on October 21, 2013. No party applied for intervenor status in this proceeding.

The Board has decided to make provision at this time for written interrogatories, interrogatory responses, submissions and reply submissions. The Board may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. Board staff shall request any information and material from Midland PUC that is in addition to Midland PUC's pre-filed evidence with the Board, and that is

relevant to the hearing, by written interrogatories filed with the Board and served to Midland PUC on or before **November 18, 2013**.

- 2. Midland PUC shall file with the Board complete written responses to the interrogatories on or before **December 2, 2013.**
- Board staff wishing to file a written submission shall do so by December 16,
 2013. Any submission should be filed with the Board and delivered to Midland PUC.
- Midland PUC may file a written reply submission with the Board by January 17, 2014.

All filings to the Board must quote the file number, EB-2013-0151, be made through the Board's web portal at https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at http://www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
