**AND IN THE MATTER OF** an application by Erie Thames Powerlines Corporation for an order or orders to dispose Account 1562 – Deferred Payments in Lieu of Taxes ("Deferred PILs").

## PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 2 November 25, 2013

Erie Thames Powelines Corporation ("Erie Thames") filed a complete application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on August 21, 2013 under section 78 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), for permission to dispose of the balance in Account 1562, Deferred Payments in Lieu of Taxes ("Account 1562") over a one year period commencing January 1, 2014.

The Board issued a Notice of Application and Hearing and Procedural Order No.1 dated September 3, 2013. No party applied for intervenor status in this proceeding.

Pursuant to Procedural Order No. 1, Board staff filed interrogatories on September 27, 2013 and Erie Thames filed interrogatory responses on October 11, 2013.

On November 13, 2013 Erie Thames filed an update to its application to reflect subsequent changes in light of its responses to Board staff interrogatories.

The Board will make provision for written submissions by Board staff and written reply by Erie Thames on the proposals set out by Erie Thames in its updated application.

The Board considers it necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding.

## THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Written submissions from Board staff with respect to the updated application shall be filed with the Board and delivered to Erie Thames on or before December 2, 2013.
- 2. Erie Thames may file a written reply submission with the Board on or before December 9, 2013.

All filings to the Board must quote the file number, EB-2013-0225, be made through the Board's web portal at <a href="https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/">https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/</a>, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at <a href="http://www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry">http://www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry</a>. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
