Re: Application by Ontario Power Generation Inc. – 2014/2015 Payment Amounts Application – EB2-13-0321

I am a consultant to the Consumers Council of Canada (“Council”). I have been instructed by my client to intervene in the Application by Ontario Power Generation Inc. for approval for the amount it charges for the output for its nuclear generating facilities and most of its hydroelectric generating facilities.

The Council is a public-interest entity which represents the interests of residential consumers of electricity and natural gas in Ontario. The Board’s order in this proceeding will ultimately impact the amounts that residential consumers will pay for electricity.

The Council intends to ask for an order of costs in this proceeding. The Council has participated in many of the Ontario Energy Board’s electricity distribution rate applications and policy consultation processes over a long period of time. In all of those proceedings the Council has been recognized as being eligible for an award of costs. In the absence of an award of costs the Council would be unable to participate in this proceeding.
