Re: NextEra Energy Canadian Operating Services, Inc. - Application to Amend Electricity Generation Licence (EG-2012-0311)

On behalf of NextEra Energy Canadian Operating Services, Inc. ("NECOSI"), we are hereby filing a request to amend NECOSI's Electricity Generation Licence (EG-2012-0311).

NECOSI seeks to amend Schedule 1 of EG-2012-0311 so as to authorize NECOSI as the licensed operator for two additional renewable energy generation facilities, namely the Bornish Wind Energy Centre and the Adelaide Wind Energy Centre. Concurrent with this request, Bornish Wind, LP has filed an application for an Electricity Generation Licence in respect of the ownership of the Bornish Wind Energy Centre and Kerwood Wind, Inc. has filed an application for an Electricity Generation Licence in respect of the ownership of the Adelaide Wind Energy Centre. The amendments are required now that each of the projects has received Notice to Proceed from the Ontario Power Authority under the Feed-in Tariff Program and to ensure that all licensing matters are in place in time for the respective facilities to go into service.

The Bornish Wind Energy Centre is located at 32185 Kerwood Road, Parkhill, Ontario, NoM 2K0. It is an on-shore wind generation facility that includes 45 wind turbines and has a gross nameplate capacity of 72.9 MW, and is being developed and operated pursuant to a contract with the Ontario Power Authority under the Feed-in Tariff Program (FIT Reference # 002173-WIN-130-601, dated July 5, 2011). Notice to Proceed was received on July 22, 2013 and the facility is expected to reach commercial operation by June 14, 2014. The Bornish Wind Energy Centre is owned by Bornish Wind, LP and will be operated by NECOSI.

The Adelaide Wind Energy Centre is located at 32185 Kerwood Road, Parkhill, Ontario, NoM 2K0.¹ It is an on-shore wind generation facility that includes 37 wind turbines and has a gross nameplate capacity of 59.9 MW, and is being developed and operated pursuant to a contract with the Ontario Power Authority under the Feed-in Tariff Program (FIT Reference #002176-

WIN-130-601, dated July 13, 2011). Notice to Proceed was received on August 22, 2013 and the facility is expected to reach commercial operation by June 14, 2014. The Adelaide Wind Energy Centre is owned by Kerwood Wind, Inc. and will be operated by NECOSI.

NECOSI also requests that the Board correct a spelling error in the current version of Schedule 1 by deleting the reference to "Consetogo" and replacing it with "Conestogo".

On behalf of NECOSI, we confirm that there have been no changes to the licensee's organizational structure since the licence was most recently amended on February 14, 2013. There have, however, been recent changes to the licensee's address, as well as to its key individuals and licence primary contact, as follows.


