How we are affected by outcome: We believe that the outcome of this hearing could lead to a greater number of antenna radiating a class 2B carcinogen into people's bedrooms than would be economically viable if competitive pricing were required.

1. We do not believe it is in the best interests of the Canadian public to create such a pricing incentive for mobile companies to mount antenna on hydro poles and light standards. We believe that pricing should be competitive.

2. The radiation emitted by wireless antenna are classed by WHO IARC as a 2B carcinogen. Antenna emitting wireless radiation should be managed differently than wireline attachment to hydro poles.
