Burlington Hydro is filing the two enclosed interrogatory responses in confidence; they are:

- The response to School Energy Coalition Interrogatory 9 ("SEC 9"); and
- The response to School Energy Coalition Interrogatory 17 ("SEC 17").

Burlington Hydro will publicly file a redacted response to SEC IR 9. The response to SEC 17 provides a proprietary study by Hay Consultants that compares Burlington Hydro's compensation levels to those of other utilities and of other industrial firms.

Burlington Hydro seeks confidential treatment of the response to SEC 9 in order to preserve its bargaining position with respect to collective agreement negotiations that will commence in the second quarter of 2014. Burlington Hydro seeks confidential treatment of the Hay study on the grounds that the study is Hay's proprietary work product and key to their ongoing commercial success.

In the event that the Board is unable to accord these documents confidential treatment Burlington Hydro will retract them.
