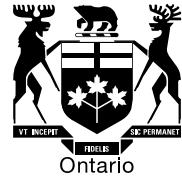

The Board received on March 7, 2014 a letter from counsel to Messrs. Atkinson and Coe and Atkinson Farms (collectively “Atkinson and Coe”) advising that Mr. Jack Kottelenberg is out of the country and asked that his proposed upcoming testimony at the scheduled March 10, 2014 hearing be transmitted via Skype.

In a letter dated March 5, 2014, the Board indicated that it will hear submissions from parties regarding Mr. Kottelenberg’s participation in the proceeding as a preliminary matter.

Rule 34.01 of the Board’s *Rules of Practice and Procedure* contemplates electronic hearings. The Board’s facilities are also equipped to accommodate testimony via Skype.

The Board will hear submissions from the parties regarding the appropriateness of allowing Mr. Kottelenberg to testify via Skype as part of the preliminary issues. And, the Board asks that Mr. Kottelenberg be on standby to appear via Skype at 11 am on March 10, 2014, as necessary. The Board requires counsel for Atkinson and Coe to appropriately inform and make all necessary arrangements with Mr. Kottelenberg and to

establish a communication channel with Mr. Kottelenberg to facilitate ready access during the proceeding.
