I am contacting you in regard to a recent Ontario Energy Board Notice in my local newspaper. The file number for the project is EB-2013-0421. After reading the notice I realized that the board will not be considering any factors such as environmental, health, aesthetics or property value impacts. This is due to Hydro One completing a Class Environmental Assessment in 2010. I was not aware they had done this assessment and do not recall receiving any information. I have seen other transfer stations in my area and they are almost always right next to the road. The site of the proposed transfer station appears to be right beside the road as well. It would be great if the station could be built a minimum of 150' from the road and then some evergreen trees could be used to hide it from view. This is a very beautiful rural area and it would be a shame to put the station in plain view when there is an opportunity not to. Please let me know your thoughts and what action affected residents and I can take to get this project completed in an way that is visually pleasing.
