This email is a follow-up to a phone call placed to your office today, Friday, March 14th 2014.

Enbridge has asked our Ontario Government Regulators for permission to increase their energy rates by 40%, as of April 1st, 2014.

They claim it's due to a "shortage" of natural gas, caused by our "extremely cold" winter. They will also claim it's a "short-term" increase in price. (During our last several warm winters, there was no mention of a reduction of rates.)

These claims are nonsense. Enbridge makes billions of dollars each year and is asking we (the consumers) to pay way more because they've had a bad quarter or two.

This email is to officially protest the proposed increase. I would like a written response detailing how the Energy Board of Ontario is going to react to this unjust and unwarranted request by Enbridge.
