**Re: Emerald Energy From Waste Inc. - Application for an Interim Electricity
Generation Licence**

On behalf of Emerald Energy From Waste Inc. ("Emerald"), we are writing to apply for an interim electricity generation licence, effective March 31, 2014.

As explained in the cover letter to Emerald's generator licence application dated February 14, 2014 (the "Original Application"), it is expected that the commercial closing of the transaction for the purchase and sale of the generation facilities at issue will be on March 31, 2014. If an interim generator license can be issued to Emerald on an expedited basis by March 31, 2014, the escrow arrangement described in the Original Application will be unnecessary, thereby avoiding the need for an operating and maintenance agreement between Emerald and Algonquin Power Energy from Waste Inc. ("Algonquin").

It is Emerald's understanding that it must notify the Board upon commercial closing and confirm that the generation facilities have been transferred to Emerald (the "Commercial Closing"). As well, Algonquin will file a letter with the Board shortly requesting that its licence (currently in the name of KMS Peel Inc.) be revoked upon the completion of the Commercial Closing and the issuance of an interim generator licence to Emerald.
