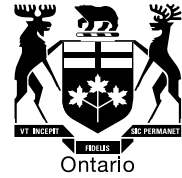

Re: Application to Determine the Location of Distribution Facilities within Road Allowances Owned by the Lambton County Board File No. EB-2014-0139

The Board has issued its Notice of Application (the "Notice") with respect to the above matter.

You are directed:

- 1) To immediately serve a copy of the Notice along with the location map that includes the affected road allowances and a copy of the application, either personally, by courier, or by registered mail on:
 - a) The Clerk of the Lambton County;
 - b) All directly affected landowners as well as encumbrancers; and

- 3) To immediately, or as soon as it is ready, have copies of the application, the pre-filed evidence and any additional materials as they are developed, made available for convenient public perusal at the offices identified in the Notice, and to post all such documents on the Jericho's website: -

- 4) To immediately provide a copy of the application and pre-filed evidence to any person upon request.
