## Re: Oakville Hydro Electricity Distribution Inc., Distribution licence ED-2003-0135 Notice of Intent to File a Z-Factor Application in relation to the December 2013 Ice Storm Event

Oakville Hydro Electricity Distribution Inc. ("Oakville Hydro") is writing to advise the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") that it intends to file a Z-Factor Application for the recovery of the costs associated with the restoration of electricity service to its customers in the Town of Oakville as a result of the damage caused by the catastrophic ice storm in December 2013.

Oakville Hydro submits that the ice storm was clearly an unforeseen event which meets the Board's Z-Factor eligibility criteria as set out in Section 2.6 of the Board's Report on 3<sup>rd</sup> Generation Incentive Regulation for Ontario's Electricity Distributors dated July 14, 2008 (the "Board's Report") and Chapter 3 of the Filing Requirements for Electricity Distribution Rate Applications, Section 3.2.2, dated July 17, 2013.

Oakville Hydro plans to file its Z-factor application as part of its next rate application in accordance with the Board's Report.
