**NOTICE OF INTERVENTION  
OF THE INDEPENDENT ELECTRICITY SYSTEM OPERATOR**

1. The Independent Electricity System Operator (the "IESO") received notice of the application identified above and requests intervenor status in the hearing of this matter.
2. The IESO is a non-profit, non-share capital corporation established under the *Electricity Act, 1998* to administer the Ontario wholesale power markets and to direct the operation and maintain the reliability of the IESO-controlled grid. The IESO's role and responsibilities are established by legislation, its licence issued by the Ontario Energy Board and the Market Rules.
3. The Ontario Power Authority ("OPA") is responsible for, amongst other things, the long-term forecasting and planning of electricity resources for Ontario. In fulfilling their respective mandates, the IESO and OPA often share information and coordinate activities as required.
4. Due to this relationship, the IESO has an interest in all aspects of the proceeding. The IESO intends to participate by filing interrogatories or making written submissions as necessary.
