I am writing to the Ontario Energy Board on behalf of SunEdison LLC to register our intent to participate in the Rate Design for Electricity Distributors Board File No. EB-2012-0410. We appreciate the opportunity to prepare comments on the draft OEB report and the ability to attend stakeholder meetings.

SunEdison is a global provider of solar energy services. As one of the largest solar energy companies in North America, SunEdison develops, finances, installs, operates, monitors, and maintains solar developments around the world. SunEdison is also a leading provider of silicon wafers to the semiconductor and solar industries, SunEdison has a global perspective with respect to the solar industry.

In 2007, SunEdison invested in Ontario because of this province's market potential and the government's direction on renewable energy. Our Canadian headquarters has over 45 employees based in Toronto, focused on developing and delivering solar energy to Ontario. SunEdison has created approximately 600 part-time and full-time jobs in Ontario, and has also invested significantly in the manufacturing of green energy products in the province.

Through the arrangement between SunEdison and Flextronics, MEMC brand solar modules are now being manufactured at the Flextronics facility in Newmarket. This facility employs 400 people from the local community. In addition, SunEdison achieved commercial operation of Ontario's first Feed-in Tariff (FIT) contracted utility-scale solar generation project in Ingleside in March 2012.

Today we have 130 MW installed and 100 MW under contract with the Ontario Power Authority. This consultation is important to us because we are generators with projects in operation and others to be constructed in the very near future. The discussion and decisions made at this juncture will have an impact on our business.
