Re: East Durham Wind, LP amended application for an electricity generation licence EB-2014-0142

We are counsel for NextEra Energy Canada, ULC ("**NextEra**"), East Durham Wind, Inc., East Durham Wind, LP and East Durham Wind GP, ULC.

On March 20, 2014, we submitted an application for an electricity generation licence on behalf of East Durham Wind, Inc. for the East Durham Wind Energy Centre ("**EDWEC**"), along with the required fee. East Durham Wind, Inc. applied as the owner of the EDWEC.

As a result of a corporate re-organization among affiliates associated with NextEra, East Durham Wind, Inc. will transfer its assets to East Durham Wind, LP. The purpose of the corporate reorganization is to facilitate cost-effective and efficient management of the NextEra affiliates. The reorganization will have no impact on the construction or operation of the EDWEC. The difference is purely one of legal structure. As the Board is aware, a corporation is a legal entity that is separate from its shareholders and considered by law to be a separate person with the full rights and abilities to act as a natural person. A limited partnership is comprised of at least one general partner and at least one limited partner. The general partner has unlimited liability for partnership liabilities and is responsible for managing the business of the limited partnership.

The Board has granted generation licences to both corporations and to limited partnerships, and the latter example includes a number of NextEra entities (Summerhaven, Conestogo and Bornish are all limited partnerships that have been granted generation licences). The Board has also granted leave to construct to limited partnerships (Summerhaven and Bornish, for example). The Board has not distinguished between the two legal forms in granting approvals and legal form has not been an issue in these approvals.



Accordingly, please find attached an amended application for an electricity generation licence submitted by <u>East Durham Wind GP, ULC on behalf of East Durham Wind, LP.</u> There is no change to the information in the previously-submitted application except the name of the applicant and change from corporation to partnership.

We request that communications regarding this application be directed to both the Applicant at the address provided in the application and to counsel at the address provided above and in the application.

In order to effect an orderly transition of the corporate reorganization, the Applicant respectfully requests that the Board dispose of this matter by May 30, 2014.
