DECISION AND ORDER ON COST AWARDS May 5, 2014

Background

PUC Distribution Inc. ("PUC") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on October 11, 2013 under section 78 of the Act, seeking approval for changes to the rates that PUC charges for electricity distribution, effective May 1, 2014.

On November 13, 2013, the Board issued Procedural Order No. 1, granting the Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition ("VECC") intervenor status and cost award eligibility with respect to PUC's request for a Lost Revenue Adjustment Mechanism.

On March 13, 2014, the Board issued its Decision and Rate Order, in which it set out the process for VECC to file its cost claim, for PUC to object to the claim and for VECC to respond to any objections raised by PUC.

The Board received a cost claim from VECC. No objection was received from PUC.

Board Findings

The Board has reviewed VECC's cost claim and finds that VECC is eligible for 100% of its reasonably incurred costs of participating in this proceeding. The Board finds that VECC's claim is reasonable and shall be reimbursed by PUC.

THE BOARD THEREFORE ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Pursuant to section 30 of the Ontario *Energy Board Act, 1998*, PUC shall immediately pay the Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition \$537.89.
- 2. Pursuant to section 30 of the Ontario *Energy Board Act, 1998*, PUC shall pay the Board's costs of and incidental to, this proceeding immediately upon receipt of the Board's invoice.
