Horizon Utilities Corporation Application to Amend Licensed Service Area of Distribution Licence ED-2006-0031

Horizon Utilities Corporation ("Horizon") has filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") dated September 12, 2006 under section 74 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c.15 (Schedule B) to amend its licensed service area. The proposed service area expansion would allow Horizon to supply electricity to the Summit Park Phase Three development project.

The Summit Park Phase Three development project is located within Hydro One Networks Inc.'s ("Hydro One") licensed service area. Phases One and Two of the Summit Park development project were the subject of two earlier service area amendments for Horizon's distribution licence. On June 15, 2005, the Board issued a Decision and Order to amend Horizon's distribution license to include Phase One of the Summit Park project and on February 17, 2006, the Board issued a Decision and Order to include Phase Two of this project.

The Summit Park Phase Three development project consists of forty-nine residential homes.

The legal description of the land that is the subject of this service area amendment application is as follows:

The property is known as - The former Township of Binbrook in the former Township of Glanbrook as of December 31, 1973, now in the City of Hamilton and described as Part

of Township Lot Seven (7), Block Five (5) in the First Concession of the Geographic Township of Binbrook and known as Summit Park Phase 3, on Plan 62M except for the following addresses (which are excluded);

- 70 Fletcher Road East, Hannon, Ontario, L0R 1P0
- 80 Fletcher Road East, Hannon, Ontario, LOR 1P0

Your letter of intervention should indicate your preference for a written or oral hearing, and the reasons for that preference. The Board will not be ordering costs in this proceeding. You must provide a copy of your letter of intervention to the applicant.
