EB-2012-0451, EB-2012-0433 and EB-2013-0074 Decision on Costs (the "Cost Decision"), the Council of Canadians Motion to Review the Cost Decisions, (the "COC Motion") and Board File Number EB-2014-0185

We are counsel to the Association of Power Producers of Ontario ("APPrO") in the above-mentioned matters. Further to the Council of Canadian's ("COC") Motion Record dated April 17, 2014, APPrO's letter to the Board dated April 22, 2014, and subsequent email and voice mail communications between Norton Rose Fulbright and Ontario Energy Board Staff, we wish to clarify APPrO's position on the above-mentioned matter.

On April 22, 2014, APPrO wrote to the Board to address certain mischaracterizations of APPrO costs in the COC Motion included in the COC Motion Record materials. APPrO did not, and does not, intend to bring a separate motion to review and/or vary the Cost Decision. APPrO did, however, wish to ensure the veracity of the Board's record in the COC Motion. If the Board, following receipt of this information and the record, so clarified, wishes to reconsider a full award of APPrO's costs claimed as part of the COC Motion, APPrO would be amenable to such an approach. As a result, unless the Board directs otherwise, APPrO does not believe that there is a need for a separate proceeding and motion number as a result of APPrO's April 22, 2014 letter (EB-2014-0185) and hereby confirms that APPrO does not intend to file any further materials on this matter, subject to any procedural order or other guidance from the Board on this or the COC Motion. APPrO is happy to speak to its April 22, 2014 letter in the context of the COC Motion, should it assist the Board.
