We are counsel to NextEra Energy Canadian Operating Services Inc. (“NEC OSI”). On March 20, 2014, NEC OSI filed a request to amend Schedule 1 of NEC OSI’s Electricity Generation Licence (EG-2012-0311) to include the operation of the East Durham Wind Energy Centre (“EDWEC”).

The purpose of this letter is to correct the following two sentences in NEC OSI’s amendment application: “The EDWEC will be owned by East Durham Wind, Inc. East Durham Wind, Inc. is applying for an electricity generation licence under separate cover.”

The above-noted sentences should read: “The EDWEC will be owned by East Durham Wind, LP. East Durham Wind, LP is applying for an electricity generation licence under separate cover.”¹

The foregoing does not change the amendment requested to NEC OSI’s generation licence, namely, that Schedule 1 of NEC OSI’s Electricity Generation Licence (EG-2012-0311) be amended to include the operation of the EDWEC.
